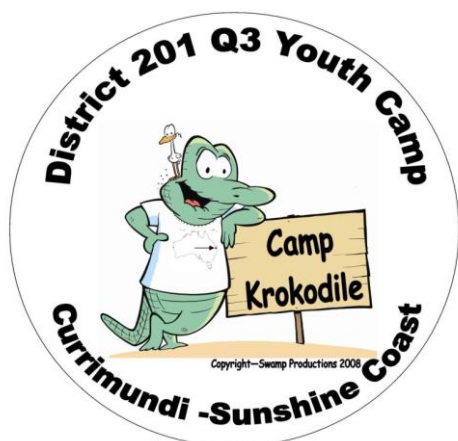

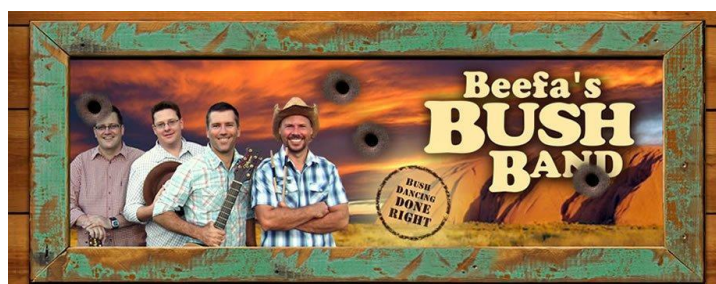

Camp Information

Camp Rules:

- Camp and home-stay rules apply in accordance with Lions Youth Exchange Policy and International Youth Camp Policy.
- Internet is not available at Camp Krokodile.
- Camp Krokodile is a drug and alcohol-free event. Anyone caught breaking this rule will immediately be excluded from camp activities.

Location:

- Currimundi – Queensland – Australia. One hour from the State Capital of Brisbane on the Sunshine Coast.
- Short walk to Pacific Ocean Surf Beaches

Language and Health:

- English is the official language of the Camp.
- Participants should have moderate or good language skills
- Participants should be fit and healthy and able to participate in physical activities

Climate:

- Camp Krokodile is held during the Australian winter time
- Temperatures are mild and vary from 14°C to 22°C during the day and from 5 to 10 degrees Celsius at night.
- Warm clothes may be required at night with a hat, sunglasses and sunscreen recommended during the day.

Camp Facilities:

- Cabins hold up to 12 campers in two rooms who share an ensuite bathroom – all linen is provided – Cabins will be allocated on a Male Only/Female Only basis
- Meals are provided from a well equipped kitchen with everything provided.
- Convection heater with control in each room and a fully automatic washing machine and dryer is provided.
- A surf beach is within walking distance so bring your swimming costume and an extra towel.

**Application and Registration Procedures**

- Only youth from countries participating in the Australian Lions Youth Exchange Program are eligible to apply for Camp Krokodile.
- Overseas youth can apply for the Lions Youth Exchange Program through their local Lions Club and Lions District Youth Exchange Chairperson.
- Australian applicants should contact their local Lions Club.
- If you don't know how to contact your local Lions Club, please contact Camp Krokodile for assistance.

Registration Forms:

- Camp Registration forms are only emailed to youth who have been accepted into the Lions Youth Exchange Program to Australia.
- Forms must be typewritten or handwritten clearly. A valid registration form must have all required information and signatures.
- The Camp fee **MUST** accompany the registration form.
